Anchitect's statement: The statecase is an intrinsic part of the very cose of this house. The stairwell acts as a lightwell and ventilation stack as well as the circulation hub and entry to the house.

Lack of available space around the stair and the desire for a feeling of enhanced lightness and airiness were the russons behind the stair being designed and detailed in a very lightweight manner. Open usads of solid jarrah span between the zine arc-sprayed steel stringers. The balastrade design beings the exterior detailing of the house to the interior with the use of stainless steel rigging wire, which is embraided and tensioned to form the vertical balastras between the zine arc-sprayed steel frame. A solid jarrah oval-shaped handrail ties the materials together to pggvide a smooth, reasuring touch.

The openness and lightweight detailing of the bar enhances one's general awareness of the dynamics of movement between spaces, this idea being an important feature of the overall design of the house.
